A one-day IOSH-certified workshop

Overview

This one-day course gives anyone with leadership responsibility the practical knowledge and the strategic solutions needed for sustainable business advantage through good safety and health practice.

It is focused on delivering the knowledge and skills that:

through effective leadership of the health and safety agenda.

Objectives

The programme is designed to help leaders:

- Reduce accident rates, absence and sick leave

Who should attend?

Workshop format

• Usually delivered as a one-day session (can be run as an overview half-day session if preferred, without the IOSH certificate)

- Highly interactive, with plenty of discussion around different scenarios and issues of specific concern to you and your organisation
- As a certificated programme, there's an assessment at the end of the session. Learners use the IOSH diagnostic tool, accessed via a mobile app, to identify their current safety and health position against a set of critical questions. The tool recommends the actions they should take. At the end of the programme they make a commitment to a personal action plan to improve their own and their organisations' safety and health management.

This is an IOSH certification programme.

Using a pre-course diagnostic tool, the session can be tailored to your organisation, sector or geographical location, making it relevant to any industry in any part of the world.
